An architect is like an engineer, an artist, and a designer all in one. The architect creates a building design and then acts as an advisor during its construction. One very famous architect is I. M. Pei, who has a unique style. Pei uses various materials, surfaces, and spaces to create his "masterpieces." He is perhaps most known for utilizing glass in striking geometric shapes and colors, along with irregular silhouettes in an International Style of architecture. Pei served as the Director of Architecture with Webb and Knapp, one of the largest real estate developers in the U.S., before forming his own architectural firm in the 1950s. He has designed numerous buildings all over the world. Some of Pei's most famous works include the National Center of Atmospheric Research in Boulder, Colorado (1967), the East Wing of the National Gallery of Art in Washington, D.C. (1978), the Louvre Pyramid in Paris (1989), the Bank of China Tower in Hong Kong (1990), and the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in Cleveland, Ohio (1998).
